JUDGMENT AND DECREE.

And now on this 8th day of January, A. D. 1924,
it being in the January term of the aforesaid court, and
the plaintiff appearing in person and with her witnesses
and by her attorneys, Kimball, Peterson, Smith & Peterson,
and the defendant appearing not nor anyone for him, and it
appearing to the Court that the defendant was personally
served with original notice in said cause in time for this
term of court, and the Court being fully advised in the pre-
mises and having inspected the pleadings and heard the proof
of plaintiff and her witnesses, finds that the equities are
with the plaintiff, and

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that
plaintiff be and she is hereby granted an absolute decree of
divorce from the defendant, Alva Graybill, on the grounds of
cruel and inhuman treatment and restored to all the rights of
an unmarried person except the right to remarry within one
year, and


It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that

plaintiff be and she is hereby given the absolute care, custody and control of the minor children of the parties hereto, being Harold, aged fifteen; Lois, aged twelve; and Wesley, aged four, the Court having found that plaintiff is a fit and proper person to have the custody of said children and that defendant is not a proper person to have such custody.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that plaintiff be and she is hereby declared to be the absolute and complete owner of the property known and described as Lot 1 in Block 3, Hughes & Doniphan's Addition to the city of Council Bluffs, Iowa, and title thereto is quieted in plaintiff.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that plaintiff have and receive from the defendant the sum of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars per month permanent alimony commencing on the 8th day of January, 1924, and Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars per month thereafter until the minor child of the parties, Wesley Graybill, shall have attained his majority, and

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that plaintiff have and recover from the defendant the sum of Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars attorneys' fees and the court costs of this action taxed at Nine & 70/100 (\$9.70) Dollars and accruing costs, and that execution issue for all sums including permanent alimony, attorneys' fees, and suit money and that interest be allowed upon said permanent alimony at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum.
