Sec. 664.14. Change in Title Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court, and the name of the person or persons to whom said estate is granted by judgment or decree, will hereafter be changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall cause a copy of the original record of said court to be sent to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
