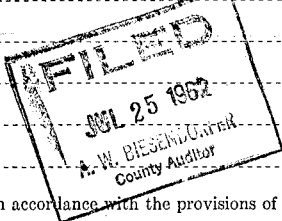

Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, or final order of a court, the auditor shall, upon the order of the court, certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
