

Sec. 606. 12. Change in Title. Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any court of record, or in any court of record of any county or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or other legal process, the auditor of the county in which the same is located, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
