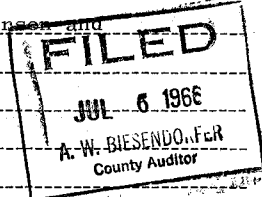

Section 606.14. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, partition or other proceeding, the clerk of the court in which said judgment or decree or will or partition or other proceeding is entered shall, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
