Section 6864. Where the title of any real estate is fraudulently transferred in any form, or removed by judgment or decree, or whose title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate court, or is otherwise fraudulently transferred, the court shall, at the request of the party aggrieved, issue an order directing the clerk of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
