Section 896 14. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment or decree, the auditor of the county in which the land is located, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment or decree, the auditor of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
