Section 606.14. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person or persons by judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, the clerk of the court, upon the entry of the judgment, shall, in conformity with the order of the court, cause the title to be changed in the records of the county auditor, and the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the district court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
