Section 6814. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, or by final order of said court or of the court of appeals, or by final order of the court of appeals, or by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify, on the same, under the seal of said court, the names of the parties to the proceedings in which said land is located.
