Where the auditor of a county has been notified by the owner or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment or decree of said court, or where a deed of the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
