Section 686.14. Change in Title - Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons, or in any corporation, or in any partnership, or in any trust, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall, after the filing of the deed, or of such other instrument, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
