Section 66.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to real estate is changed by deed, mortgage, or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by the death of the owner, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
