Section 6614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the district court of the county in which said land is located, the auditor, clerk, or assessor of said county, upon the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in private, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the county, to the assessor of said county, who shall thereupon cause the same to be entered in the county in which said land is located.
