Section 6814. Change of Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court of this state, and the same is duly recorded, the clerk of said court, upon the application of the person or persons in whose favor such judgment or decree was rendered, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
