Section 906.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the clerk of said court, the auditor of said county, upon the judgment, decree, will, proceeding or order in proof, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said county, to the county auditor of this county in which said land is located.
