Section 606.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which said land is located, shall, upon the filing of such judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
