Section 6814. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the county auditor, and the same is duly recorded, the county auditor, judge, clerk, or other officer having the custody of the records, shall certify, under the seal of said county, a copy of said records to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
