Section 606.14. Change in Title—Certification. When the auditor of a county has received a duly authenticated copy of a return of property for taxation from any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment or decree of the supreme court, or where the date of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
