the title of any real estate is finally established in any person  
by judgment or decree of said court or of the  
supreme court of this state, and is duly recorded, the auditor  
judgment, decree, will, proceedings, or order in probate the  
seat of said court, and certify the same, under the  
seal of said county, to the county auditor of the county in  
which said land is located.
