Section 661.1. Change in Title.—Confirmation. When the proper legal title is established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is sold, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
