Section 683.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person by judgment or decree of said court or of the county auditor, and the same is thereafter changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
