Section 668.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any state or federal court, or in any court of record, or in any supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the county auditor shall certify to the county auditor the fact that the title has been so established, and the county auditor shall enter the same in the records of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
