Section 686.4. Change in Title.—Certification. When the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the county auditor, or by deed, or by will, or by operation of law, or by any other means, the county auditor, in his judgment, deems, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the seal of said district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said county, and the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
