Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person, firm, partnership, or corporation, by a judgment of the supreme court, or where title to real estate passes by the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which the land is located, shall, upon the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
