

Section 6814. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person, firm, or corporation, by a final judgment of the supreme court, or where title to said real estate is determined by a final judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which said real estate is located, the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
