Section 668.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally determined by the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or otherwise, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall certify the same under the seal of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
