Section 626.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title to any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or by deed, or by will, or by operation of law, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the hand and seal of the clerk, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
