Section 6814. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding in a court of record, or in a proceeding in any appellate court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall, upon the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
