Section 606.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding by a court of competent jurisdiction, or by the supreme court, or where title to real estate is obtained by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the county auditor shall cause a change of title to be made in the book of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
