Section 661.4. Change in Title—Certification. Where the title to real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction, or where title to real estate is changed by the operation of law, or by the proceedings, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify to the county auditor of said county, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
