Section 6614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person by judgment, decree, or order of said court or of the supreme court, and such judgment, decree, or order is duly entered, docketed, with proceeding, or order in private, the clerk of said court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
