Section 606.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is changed by deed, mortgage, judgment, decree, will, probate, or otherwise, the auditor of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, probate, or otherwise, the auditor of the supreme court, shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
