Section 606.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established by a judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, the auditor of the county in which said estate is located shall, upon receipt of a certified copy of such judgment, decree, or order, proceed to change the title of said estate in the records of the county, and the auditor of the county in which said land is located.
