Section 6614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any proceeding in the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which said land is located, the seat of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
