Section 606.14. Change in Title - Confirmation. Where the title of any real estate is changed in any person or person or persons, or where title to real estate is transferred by deed, mortgage, or other instrument, the auditor, upon receiving the judgment, decree, will, probate, or other instrument, shall certify the same, under the seal of his court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
