the title to any real estate finally established in any person
or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of
the supreme court, or otherwise, is changed by
the same court, or otherwise, with proceedings, or order in probate, the
clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the
seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in
which said land is located.
