Section 6614. Change in Title.—Confirmation. Where the record of a sale is duly established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate in said county is transferred by deed of record, or where title to real estate in said county is transferred by deed of record, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
