Section 686.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person, partnership, corporation, or other legal entity, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the county auditor shall certify to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
