Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment, decree, or order of the supreme court, or of any court of appeals, or of any court of judgment, decree, will, probate, or order in public, the clerk of said court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
