Section 86614, Change in Title.—Certification. Where a change in title is made by deed, mortgage, or process by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by the operation of law, the auditor of the county in which said land is located shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
