the title of any real estate is finally established in any person  
or persons by a judgment of a court of record, or by a decree of a  
supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by  
contract, agreement, will, proceeding, or order in probate by  
a clerk of a court, or by a deed, or by a conveyance, or by the  
seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in  
which said land is located:
