



Section 696.14. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county which said land is located.
