

Section 606.14. Change in Title - Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by a final judgment of a court of record or by a judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the court, or the clerk of the probate court, or the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
