Section 6614. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the supreme court of this state, or by the final decision of the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the seal of said district court shall certify the same under the seal of said county and the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
