Section 636.14. Change in Title. Confirmation. Where the title of any real estate is finally established by any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the Auditor, and the same is duly recorded, the Auditor, by judgment, decree, will, proceeding or order in writing, shall cause the title of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the Auditor, to be a change of title, and the same shall be recorded in the office of the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
