Section 626.14. Change of Title. — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or person by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, or by final judgment of the district court, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the judgment, decree, or will proceeding, or order in probate, the title of the said real estate, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
