Section 602.14. Change in Title.—Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any person or persons by judgment or decree of said court or of the court of appeals, or by the final decision of the court of appeals, or by the judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the clerk of the district court shall certify the same, under the seal of the court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
