

Where the title to any real estate is changed by deed, mortgage, or persons by judgment or decree of a court of record, or by the clerk of the district court, or where title to real estate is changed by the clerk of the district court, the clerk of the district court shall, upon the seal of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
