Where the title to any real estate is transferred in any person or person by judgment or decree of said court, or by the supreme court, or where title to real estate is obtained by the purchase of a mortgage, the auditor of the county clerk of the district court shall certify the same to the clerk of said court, to the county auditor of the county in which said land is located.
