Section 536.14. Change in Title — Certification. Where the title of any real estate is finally established in any department of the state or is established by order of the supreme court, or where title to real estate is changed by judgment, decree, will, proceeding, or order in probate, the auditor of the county in which the land is located shall cause the title to be recorded in the records of the county in which said land is located.
